

Application Items:

- Submission of the DS-160 application
- A passport valid for travel to the United States with valid for intended period of travel.
- One (1) 2"x2" (5cmx5cm) photograph taken within the last six months
 - [This web page](#) has information about the required photo format
- A receipt showing payment of your US \$160 non-refundable nonimmigrant visa application processing fee paid in local currency.
 - Details on how to pay the fee are explained on step 2 of How to Apply
 - Fee is 20800 PKR
- 10-year travel history
- Your e-mail address
- List of siblings and children
- present an interview appointment letter confirming that you booked an appointment through [this service](#).
- You may also bring supporting documents you believe support the information provided to the consular officer.

How to Apply:

Step 1

Complete the [Nonimmigrant Visa Electronic Application \(DS-160\) form](#). Apply online at <https://ceac.state.gov/GenNIV/Default.aspx>.

Step 2

Pay the visa application [fee](#).

- Create an online profile first at:
 - <https://cgifederal.secure.force.com/?language=English&country=Pakistan>
 - Click on Schedule My Appointment option on the left-hand side of your screen. Complete steps for Visa Type, Post, Visa Category and Visa Class.
 - Once you are on the Payment screen, click on Payment Options
 - Print deposit slip.
 - Pay the non refundable visa fee.
 - Save the bank receipt for your records. It cannot be replaced if it is lost. **You will need the receipt number on the bank receipt to schedule your visa appointment.**

- Once you pay your visa fee, you can schedule your interview after 11:00am the next business day. Log-in to your profile and complete the Schedule Your Appointment steps with your receipt number.
- Fee payment option: **Cash at Allied Bank**
 - Must be paid in cash
 - Take the deposit slip to the bank
 - If expiration date on the slip passes prior to payment, return to website, log into your profile and reprint the slip.
 - Bring passport to bank for identification purpose to make payment
 - Save the bank receipt to schedule visa appointment**

Step 3

Schedule your appointment on [this](#) web page.

You will need the following information in order to schedule your appointment:

- Your passport number
- The receipt number from your Visa Fee receipt. (Click [here](#) if you need help finding this number.)
- The ten (10) digit barcode number from your DS-160 confirmation page

Step 4

Visit the [U.S. Embassy or Consulate](#) on the date and time of your visa interview.

- Arrive 30 minutes before your appointment time

Items to take to Embassy:

- printed copy of your appointment letter
- your DS-160 confirmation page
- one photograph taken within the last six months
- current and all old passport
